




Spinergy Stone Polishing Pads



Spinergy pads were developed to remove light wear and achieve a wide variety of finishes from dull hone (no shine) to a high polish on Marble, Travertine, Terrazzo or Limestone floors, walls or counter tops with little to no lippage (uneven tiles). Easy to use with any 175-300 rpm floor scrubber. These unique pads are washable and re-usable.

Available in 5", 7", 17" and 20" diameter with five different grit sizes for different levels of polishing.



PAD COLOR	GRIT SIZE	USAGE
RED	800	Satin Hone
PURPLE	1,500	Pre-Polish
BLUE	3,000	Polish
YELLOW	8,000	Shine
GREEN	11,000	Ultra Shine

Improper use of pads and cleaning chemicals can damage floors. Contact your Viper distributor for training and other information on proper floor care procedures.

The following information will help you get the best performance and extend the service life of your Spinergy pads:

- Pads are made of hog's hair, bonding agent and diamond abrasives. The side with the colored spot goes against the drive block. The plain side is the working surface which goes on the floor or stone surface.
- Contamination can ruin the pads. To reduce possible pad contamination:
- Be sure to rinse the floor being polished before starting and between the application of pads of different grits. Loose diamonds from one grit size can contaminate another so it will not polish above a certain level.
- Proper cleaning and storage is necessary to remove contamination and extend the service life of your Spinergy Pads.

CLEANING: After use pads should be rinsed thoroughly.

- Rinse with normal water pressure. Do not use high pressure water such as from a truckmount. This may loosen the bonding agent and you may lose some of the diamonds. This will reduce the useful life of the pads.
- Pads should be rinsed from the back first. Flush the water through the pad, back to front. Then rinse the pad again from the front and again from the back. It is natural to see a light residue on the pads even after thorough rinsing. This is dried slurry from the polished stone. It does not necessarily indicate contamination.

STORAGE: Proper Storage prevents contamination.

- Store the pads with the plain side on the first pad in contact with the side with the colored spot on the next pad. Do not store them face to face as to avoid contaminating one pad with the different diamond grit from the other pad.
- Store the pads in their original box and do not wrap in plastic or other material that will prevent them from drying. Hog's hair can support mold growth easily.
- Abrasive material can also be picked up from dirty floors so do not lay the pads out to dry on shop floors etc.
